## **Call for submissions**

We invite all presenters (oral presentations and posters) to submit a manuscript for consideration for a special issue of the journal *Isogloss* <https://revistes.uab.cat/isogloss/index>. The special issue will be published as part of the series Romance Languages and Linguistic Theory (RLLT). Information about the series can be found at the following link:

## **General information**

All manuscripts will be reviewed according to the reviewing model used at *Isogloss*. There will be 3 reviews per manuscript and the recommendations of the reviewers are ACCEPT, ACCEPT WITH MINOR REVISIONS, ACCEPT WITH REVISIONS or REJECT. We plan on accepting 20 papers that receive positive reviews with the fewest recommended revisions based on reviewer feedback.

## **Timeline and important dates**

We anticipate the entire publication process to take approximately one year (hopefully, it will be less but this will depend on how quickly we can find willing/available reviewers for each manuscript). Here are some important dates to keep in mind if you plan to submit a manuscript:

- Deadline to submit manuscripts: November 1, 2022
- Reviews submitted to authors with decision to accept/reject: April/May 2023
- Final versions of manuscripts due and publication: June/July 2023

## **Length and formatting of manuscripts**

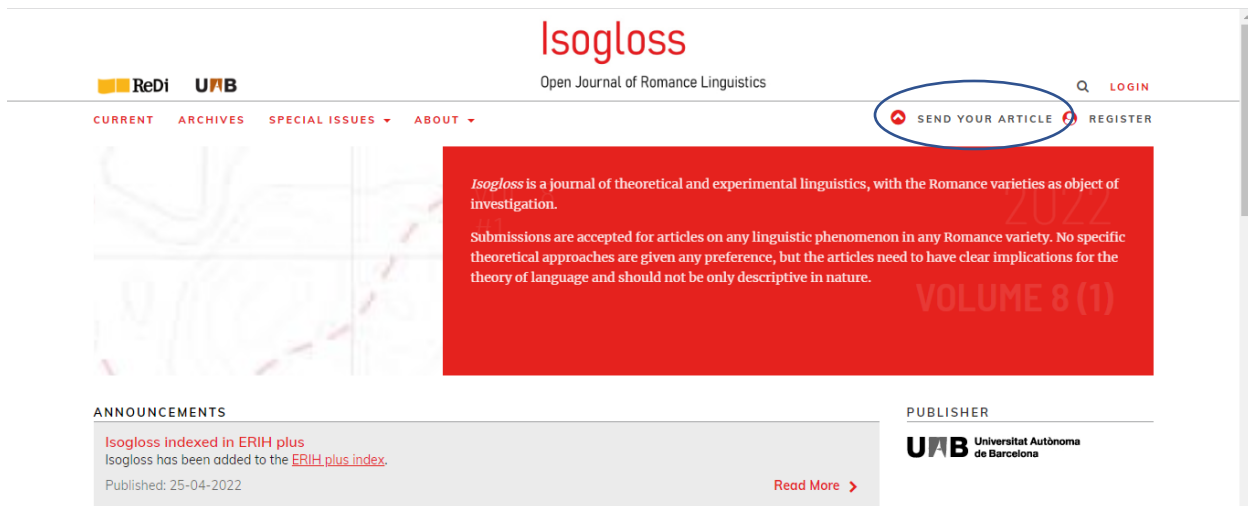
Manuscripts should be a maximum of 10,000 words including examples, tables, figures and references (approximately 20 pages). Please follow the style guidelines for *Isogloss*, which are described in detail here: <https://revistes.uab.cat/isogloss/about/submissions>

We recommend that you use the *Isogloss* Microsoft Word template in order to format your manuscript as this will greatly reduce your workload and our workload as editors during the final stages of publication. A copy of the template is attached to this email, and it can also be downloaded from the author guidelines link above.

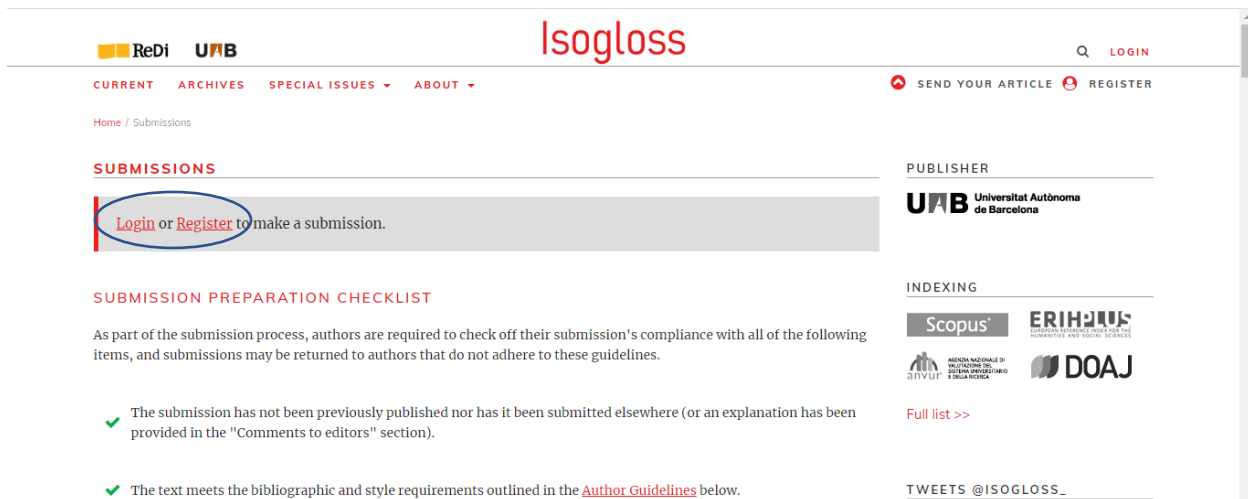
## Instructions for submission of manuscript

Manuscripts should be submitted as anonymous pdf files through the Isogloss platform. The following are the steps you should follow:

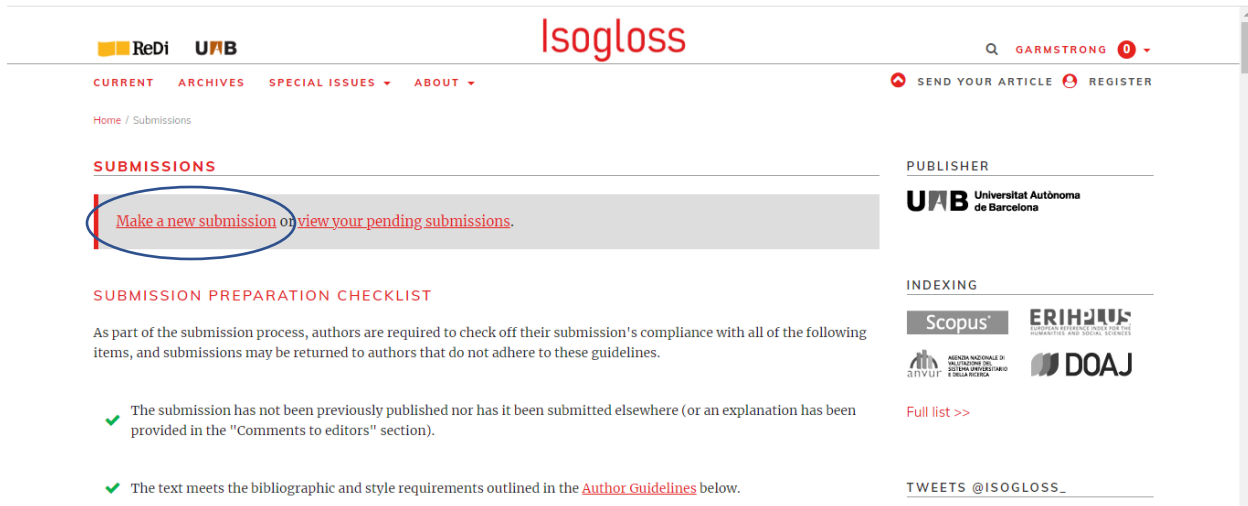
1. Go to the Isogloss website <https://revistes.uab.cat/isogloss/index> and click the link that says “Send your article”



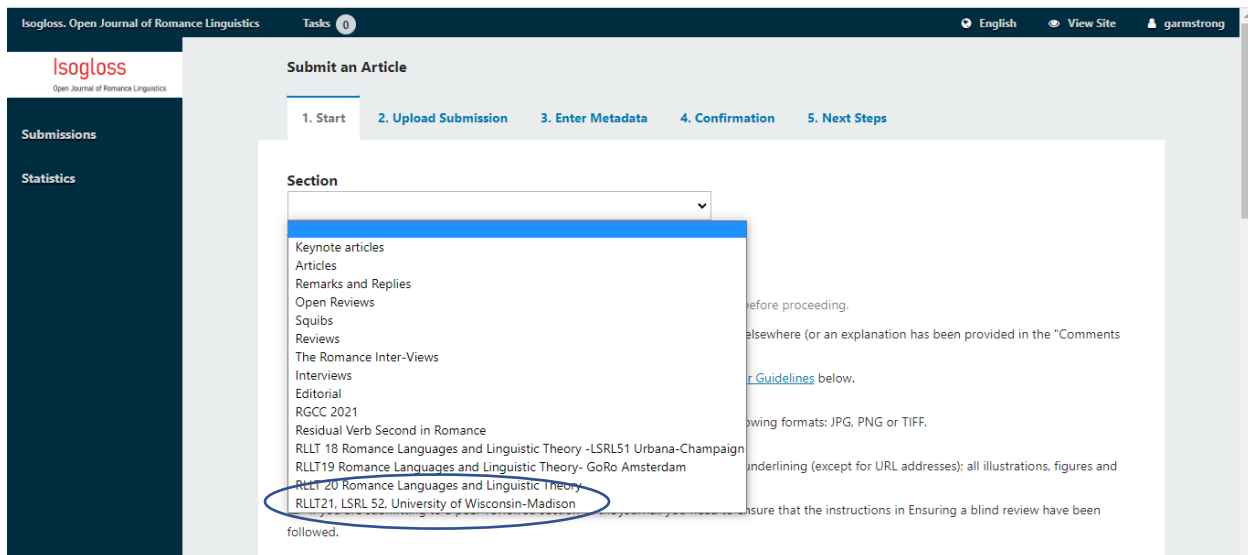
2. If you have a profile in Isogloss you should login as an author. If not, you should register and create a profile as an author.



3. Once logged in, go to “Make a new submission”



4. Once you are in the submission platform, you will see a dropdown menu under the heading “Section”. Please choose **RLLT 21, LSRL 52, University of Wisconsin-Madison**. Note: this step is very important as your paper may be difficult to retrieve if it is not in the correct section.



5. Follow the rest of the steps in order to finalize the submission.
